This striking patinated bronze bust, likely cast in France in the late 19th century, depicts a tender and emotional moment: a young couple in a passionate embrace, delicately rendered with expressive intensity and sensuality. The sculpture captures not only physical closeness but emotional connection, making it a particularly moving example of Romantic-era bronze work. The finely detailed modeling of the faces, hair, and drapery reflects the influence of 19th-century French academic sculpture, where technical precision was paired with emotional depth. The treatment of the hair--gently curled and crowned with floral garlands--along with the naturalistic folds of the garments, shows the hand of a highly skilled sculptor, possibly inspired by the works of Jean-Baptiste Carpeaux or Albert-Ernest
