This property armchair in solid cherry wood with lacrosse armrests, rests on two turned front legs in the Empire style. The seat is surrounded by a wide band slightly curved in front and is lined with real straw mulching. This very tight new mulching was carried out according to the rules of the art by the house for the blind in Nantes.

This soft-shaped armchair has a curved cathedral-shaped backrest with two central elements depicting Empire-style balusters. Solid and comfortable, this cherrywood armchair offers high-quality seating and undeniable charm.
