Description

Octagonal dish in Chinese porcelain, decoration in cobalt blue under glass representing an agricultural scene. In the foreground a buffalo with a particularly neat design. The dotted technique is used on all the patterns, it is a question of representing the reliefs by concentrating more or less the points as for the lithographs, which is a complicated and rare technique on porcelain. It took several thousand points to decorate this dish and the artist had to perfectly master the pressure of his brushstrokes because painting on a simply "smart" paste does not admit fault. We can admire this work on the enlarged photo of the dress of the buffalo.

Chinese work around 1800 late 18° or early 19° made for export. The edges have many "nibbles" due to a detachment of the glass, which is typical
