Description

Collection of 5 carding combs from the 18th century in wrought iron and wood. They are all different. These tools could also be used to untangle hemp to make ropes. Very nice forging work. A comb has an interesting grip in the shape of an awl. It was used to make splices in the ropes. All these tools are in very good condition, brushed and waxed. Normal wear: missing 1 tooth at 1 and a few peaks on the one with short claw. Width: 19.5 cm, 13.8 cm, 13.4 cm, 15.5 cm. Long: 21 cm, 21.5 cm, 20.2 cm, 14.1 cm. The awl-shaped one: width: 8 cm, long: 13.9 cm. Awl: 35.1 cm.
