THE Fiddle-SHAPED TOP IS IN AMBOINE BULF VENEER FRAMED IN MAHOGANY SCARFED AND MOLDED IN CORBIN BEAK. THE VENEER IS LAYED IN A SHAPE OF BUTTERFLY WINGS STARTING FROM THE CENTER

. THE TOP IS ON A SUPPORT COMPRISING TWO DRAWERS PLACED IN THE CENTER OF THE CURVED CROSS-MEMBER.
THE TABLE RESTS ON FOUR CURVED LEGS, MOLDED WITH FLORAL DECORATIONS SCULPTED AROUND A MEDALLION IN JUMP;
