Description

Sèvres porcelain vase, model in the "Gauvenet 7" shape, white and blue decorated with Arabic calligraphy motifs, signed by Boutaleb *, test carried out in Sèvres and numbered 7.5.79, from the 20th century. This vase is in very good condition. It is signed M.Boutaleb 7.5.79 as well as PG-1-79 PD hollow. This is a personal work by the artist and not an official order from Sèvres. This Arabic theme most likely refers to his original training in Algiers and his Arab-Muslim culture. However, he adds the codes of the Manufacture de Sèvres: the Gauvenet 7 shape still used, and the colors (white and Sèvres blue), which gives us this magnificent piece combining its two cultures. He was a decorator at the Sèvres factory (1945-1978). He is a member of the Society of Algerian and Orientalist Artists (Algiers). His works are in the National Museum of Fine Arts in Algiers and the city of ceramics in Sèvres. Mahieddine Boutaleb was one of the best decorators in Sèvres, he excels there in the power of forms and the refinement of colors. His pieces are present in many embassies around the world.
