cabinetmaker André-Charles Boulle, who perfected it in the 17th century. The striking juxtaposition of dark ebony and gleaming brass creates an unmistakable sense of grandeur and opulence.

**Gilt Bronze Mounts:** The desk is richly adorned with finely chased gilt bronze (ormolu) mounts. These are prominently applied to the substantial, tapering legs, the keyholes, and other hardware. Notably, a central gilded bronze medallion with a classical mask and scrollwork enhances the desk's facade. The legs are further embellished with highly sculptural acanthus and foliate mounts, extending to the feet.

**Fine Leather Writing Surface:** The top of the desk features a fine leather writing surface, combining practicality with an elegant, sophisticated finish, often bordered by further brass inlay or gilt bronze.

**Intricate Floral Marquetry:** The facade (apron and drawer fronts) and parts of the top surface are decorated with intricate floral marquetry, highlighting the skillful craftsmanship and meticulous attention to detail.

**Elaborate Apron and Stretcher:** The desk features a curved apron to the front, embellished with central gilt bronze ornamentation, and a robust X-form stretcher base with a central medallion and further bronze detailing.
