volumes constituting it; covered with decorative bindings of the time. The book contains 8 (out of 9) pretty engraved folding plates. "Famous chief surgeon of the Hôpital-Dieu in Paris" (in Quérard), Dusault "was a great surgeon, one of the first professors at the Ecole Pratique de Chirurgie. He made many suggestions regarding the treatment of fractures and dislocations and is one of the founders of modern vascular surgery. He was Bichat's teacher". (in Garisson & Morton). "This great surgeon, by his lessons, successes and his writings, greatly increased the luster of French surgery". (in Monfalcon). "It was Pierre-Joseph Desault who, by facilitating Bichat's beginnings, guided his destiny". (in Famous Doctors). "Desault is the creator of clinical teaching directed at the patient's bedside. He wrote little and to know his doctrine, we only have the Journal of Surgery and the Surgical Works; last tribute paid by the great anatomist to the memory of the one who was his master. "Chief surgeon at the Charité then at the Hôtel-Dieu in Paris, a famous professor and operator, Desault founded in France anatomy and the surgical clinic in the modern sense of these terms, popularized devices with continuous extension in the treatment of fractures and rubber catheters in urology, described several previously unknown pathological conditions and perfected the technique of several surgical procedures. He was the master of Bichat and Corvisart". (in Loonie).
