Madeleine Plantey was a pupil of Tony Tollet in Lyon. His workshop is located rue Laurencin. She painted nudes, dancers and still lifes. On Sundays, she travels the countryside to paint landscapes and pick wild flowers that make up her still life subjects. She also produces landscapes of Brittany. She exhibits in a gallery on rue Auguste Comte in Lyon, and annually presents her works "hors-concours" at the Salon
