Italian Biedermeier wardrobe in fir plated with walnut burl,
Tyrol first half of the 19th century
Of great visual impact it is certainly
the use of briar with four mirrored sectors on the
doors,
herringbone on the uprights and again in squares
on the sides,
all surrounded by a double thread in light wood.
Upper wavy cornice, also walnut plated.
Original working lock with key.
Interior set up with a top shelf and pole for
hanging clothes.
The maximum measure of the internal depth is 54
cm.
