Perfect condition Height 31.5cm Diameter at the neck 17.5cm Signed on the back Malarmey Jean-Claude Malarmey (1932-1992) Trained at the School of Fine Arts in Reims, Jean-Claude M alarmy joined Robert Pérot and Dominique Baudart at Jean Rivier's workshop in Vallauris then at the Vieux Moulin.
