These vases are sumptuously decorated with colored enamels representing the vegetation on the body and the neck. They are decorated with handles in the form of elephant heads with two trunks. There is a mianhao (signogrammed seal) under each bottom of the vase. This pair of vase will seduce, in particular by its authenticity, lovers of art and Asia.
