Referenced Lyonnais model of silk woven under the First Empire or the Restoration. Sequenced decoration with large stylized leaves and rosettes structured in a damask satin with a twill effect. Rigid red cotton lining. A few very light scuff marks on the edges. Otherwise clean and in very good condition as a textile antique. 600 euros each or 1000 euros for both. Dimensions: Two lambrequins of 80 cm at the widest, 60cm at the narrowest by 257cm for the large one and 246 cm for the smallest
