



Nineteenth Century Curved Wood And Wicker Chair



Description

Pulling chair from the 19th century Made by a craftsman, to order, around the 1860s, this chair is entirely in curved wood and woven wicker. The work done on it is absolutely remarkable, especially for the realization of the backrest in the shape of a racket, on which we see all the precision of the braiding. It is totally in the spirit of the most beautiful furniture of the time, manufactured by Thonet or other JJKöhn. What's more, it was made with a mindset full of ingenuity, with these arms that fold out thanks to this set of lockable hinges with a latch and a butterfly; and the 4 feet that allow both to put it down, but also to prevent it from tipping over. The chair is in absolutely remarkable condition, still proudly solid and reliable. The wood and the colors have acquired a patina with time to give
