First attracted by music, he devoted himself to painting from 1940 In 1950, he frequented Montparnasse artists and became friends with the sculptress, Anton Prinner with Pierre Loeb and Picasso. In 1960, he invented his own writing which he called "Figura-synthesis". "The Figura-synthesis is the image we have of an object and not the object in its form as it appears to us" In 1982: Silver Medal from the City of Paris for a Figura-synthesis Numerous works in the museums of France or Israel.
