Beautiful proof in patinated bronze after Joseph Charles Marin (1759-1834), pupil of the sculptor Clodion. He won the Grand Prix de Rome in 1801 and made the original sculpture of this work at the beginning of the 19th century. Graceful and delicate, the "young woman crowned with flowers" is a neo-classical achievement ode to femininity and beauty. Adorned with flowers intertwined in her curly hair and on her floaty dress, the muse turns her head delicately in a ravishing movement. Romantic and charming, this work enchants with its finely chiseled details and the poetry that emanates from it. \*\*\*\*\*
