Beautiful pedestal table in walnut burl, dating from the beginning of the 19th century, and topped with a Belgian gray Sainte-Anne marble in perfect condition. This side table, whose belt is veneered in burr walnut, rests on three solid walnut console legs tapering downwards. The whole is supported by a tripod base. Indeed, the base with concave sides, is in cedar burl veneer rests on three black "pancake" feet. With its unique sleek style and shimmering colors due to the use of light woods, this pedestal table will delight lovers of refined furniture. *****
