



Child's Rocking-chair In Beech, Maison Thonet - 1910



Description

Charming armchair called "Lullaby of child" in nicely curved Beech. Iconic both in its design and its manufacture, this model n°12331 from Maison Thonet is part of the quest for a minimalism dear to its creator. The Thonet house, created in 1859, revolutionized the furniture industry by patenting its process for bending wood boiled in a bath of glue, in order to make it curved. Composed of a cane backrest and seat, in perfect condition, this solid rocking seat has a patina redone identical to the original model. The Thonet marking is present under the seat. With its elegant and refined curves, this children's rocking chair from the beginning of the 20th century will delight with its warm color and authenticity. ******* Period: 1910 Excellent condition after restoration in our workshop.
