Rare Cuban mahogany commode crafted in Nantes in the 18th century. Made to order, this travel cabinet is a unique piece of furniture, used by a noble more than two centuries ago. Restored in the rules of the art, this piece of furniture is composed of a storage part opening by two doors in front with a brass element. In the lower part, the lavatory opens with a finely chiseled bronze handle. We discover a lid covering a silver metal pot. With a hand handle, this piece of furniture has four wheels for easy transport. Its precious wood and its originality make this piece of furniture an unusual creation that attracts attention. Occasional furniture, planter or other, it will find its place in a distinguished and refined interior. ***** Period: Late 18th century
