Graduated from the School of Decorative Arts and Fine arts of Paris, Jean Austruy settled in Saint-Marcellin in Isère, and taught drawing for nine years in this city as well as at the School of Fine Arts and Industrial Arts in Grenoble. ceramics first in his garage, then in a workshop
