Description

Beautiful set of late 19th century stable stalls from Laloy in Paris. "In the years 1880-90, the layout of stables was a very buoyant market, which explains the large number of companies involved in the sale of this equipment; Laloy, Rabourdin, Oranger, Cabanel, Brunet, Jardillet. ..." the fully dismantled set includes 4 stalls, one of which is double; the parts fixed to the walls are in wood, the intermediate partitions in cast iron and wood. Note a necessary restoration of wooden elements (oak) of two low iron crosspieces and a missing manger the stalls of the luxury stables of the end of the XIXth century were to be differentiated from boxes (wider) because if they are 4 meters, they are on the other hand quite narrow, they measure 1 meter 80 wide. Any master stable, equipped with stalls, must also
