Description

Claude VENARD, Mermaid at the Port Oil on canvas 166 x 136 cm Original painting by Claude Vénard, French artist who lived in Paris then in Sanary-sur-mer from the 60s. He is illustrated with a semi-abstract painting, sometimes cubist, with important touches of bright colors with black outlines. He painted views of Paris, from his studio, and of the Ports. This work is particularly significant for its aesthetic concerns: it represents a reclining woman with a fishtail, accompanied by several other silhouettes of sirens. These semi-abstract figures sit enthroned in front of a landscape with multiple layers of bright colors applied thickly with a knife. In the background, a large bridge adds a dimension to the depth of the work, the perspective of which brings us to two industrial buildings with a figurative character.
