Plate in heavy hard porcelain, nicked Ginori in green. Elporte, painted in gold and red, the coat of arms of the Bourbon-Busset family which dates back to the 15th century. The House of Bourbon-Busset is a branch of the Bourbons, considered illegitimate and non-dynastic since the decision of Louis XI of France. However, in the male line, it is the oldest branch still existing among the descendants of the Capetians.
