Vase made of laminated glass using the acid etching technique. The decorative motif is made up of aquatic plants (perhaps *caltha palustris* - marsh caltha - marsh duckling?), one of Émile Gallé's favorite subjects. Laminated, etched, ground, polished glass. Nancy, Émile Gallé factory, Art Nouveau, early 20th century.

Signature "Gallé". Height 24.9 cm, diameter 8.7 cm. Very good state of conservation. Émile Gallé's factory was famous for its top quality furniture and glassware. Gallé loved walks in the wild woods and also had his own little botanical garden. He had hung signs above his studio door: "Our roots are deep in the forest - on the banks of streams and among the moss". Free delivery in EU. ! I send parcels by insured courier (DPD or DHL).
