Description

Preparatory drawing executed in pencil and white chalk on paper by the French artist Théodore Chassériau (1819-1856), datable to the early 1850s.

The work depicts the study of a male nude for the painting *La Guerre des Gaules* (1855), now housed in the Musée d'Art Roger Quilliot in Clermont-Ferrand. The drawing corresponds specifically to the second standing figure from the left in the original composition.

The sheet measures 19 × 30 cm and bears, in the lower right corner, the artist's blue stamp, a characteristic feature of his graphic production. On the reverse, numerical pencil annotations are present, related to working notes or cataloguing
