Large ART DECO period vase signed LE VERRE FRANÇAIS. It is made of acid-etched multilayer glass with a purple-tinted purple dahlia decoration on the lower part. The background when it is nuanced with dark and light pink. Very beautiful vase of good quality The brand "Le Verre Français" was registered in 1918 by CHARLES SCHNEIDER, master glassmakers who previously worked at DAUM This collection of vases and bowls presents a plant decoration particularly appreciated, at that time, by American customers. What makes it rich is the wide variety of acid-etched decoration, presenting a contrast of materials (smooth versus matte). The colors worked are less prolific than the Schneider line also created in 1918. Its wide distribution allows it to be profitable despite the extra work
