Julien Gracq is famous thanks to the Prix Goncourt for "le Rivage des Syrtes", as well as for his loyalty to his publisher José Corti. You should not summarize the work of Julien Gracq at his Prix Goncourt and read it. Nominative copy numbered in Roman numerals, on pure Lana vellum (print run of 497 copies in total).
