Unusual stand in carved and painted wood, representing a Moor dressed in a printed shirt and wearing a turban. He presents in his left hand a bunch of grapes and holds a flower in the right one. It supports on its head a tray with a black top bordered with gilding and rests on a foliated tripod base. We can distinguish on its lower part, almost hidden under the golden paint, colorful flower patterns. Designed in the Venetian style of the 18th century, this harness of character would undoubtedly have its effect as a decorative element in a contemporary interior, where it will enhance the object it will display. *****
