Description

Beautiful fireplace bar or gallery fire in gilded bronze, Consulate period / Empire period, early 19th century circa 1800-1805. Adorned with two reclining sphinxes on the side terraces; the gallery is decorated with palmettes and stars. Our bar is a variant of another fireplace bar that we present https://www.gslr-antiques.com/fr/boutique/autres/ barre-cheminee-empire-sphinges-bronze-dore.php which is also a variant of a model from the collections of the Palace of Fontainebleau from the hotel of General Moreau from where it was removed in 1804 (cf N°265 page 264 Jean Pierre Samoyault - Clocks and bronze furniture entered under the first Empire). The author of these bronzes is not identified, but we can assume that it is a great Parisian bronzier supplier of imperial furniture such as Galle, Ravrio or Thomire. Very
