See the Art of the book P. 187. Beautiful illustrated edition of this famous picaresque novel, whose particularity is to be written in a baroque language. Here the text was translated by J.-H. Rosny and is illustrated with 120 drawings by Daniel Vierge reproduced by photogravure with copper retouching by the artist, using a process invented by Gillot. Edition limited to 440 numbered copies. This copy is unjustified on China paper (while the basic edition is on Arches vellum). It contains a continuation on China of the illustrations of Daniel Vierge. This book by Daniel Vierge has long been considered his
