Oil on canvas by the painter Francis Verlinden, unsigned, ca 1970. The technique of his painting reflects a perfect mastery of the subject (very little material used). Canvas in good condition (one touch-up done, see photo). Worn frame, ideally to retouch... Dimensions with frame (86x76cm). See our 2 other paintings by the painter (signed) on this site. Biography: Francis Verlinden is a Belgian painter illustrator and draftsman, he was born in Ixelles (Brussels) in 1935, graduated from Decorative Arts at Saint-Luc in Brussels. Trained for 5 years with the painter Paul G. Klein in Damme, which probably gave him this intuition and power of line, a "brush stroke" that many envy him, the artist paints with extreme speed and a fair line. Predilection for the figures of young women and
