Very beautiful etching signed Rembrandt. "CHRIST BEFORE PILATE AND THE PEOPLE - ECCE HOMO" In the general catalog B 77 The first print dates from 1634 26 cm x 21 cm Four light dots of glue on the back This second print, smaller than that of 1634, was engraved by Jacques le Bas in January 1775. This drawing represents the narrative version of the Ecce Homo (Jesus then came outside; he wore the crown of thorns and the purple mantle. Pilate said to them: "Behold the man!" but as soon as the high priests and their people saw him, they cried out, "Crucify him, crucify him!" Pilate said to them, "Take him yourselves and crucify him! no count of accusation against him." (John XIX, 5-6)
