Description

Still life with a bouquet of roses in a vase, oil on wood by Gaston Ploquin, painter from the Lyon School, born in Lyon in 1882 and died in the same city in 1970. Signed upper left. Some very slight lack of pictorial layer in the center and on the right of the bouquet. Patinated wooden frame, from the early 20th century. Dimensions without frame; 35 X 27.5cm. Dimensions with frame: 49 X 40.5 cm. Gaston Ploquin was a student at the School of Fine Arts in Lyon, then of the painter and decorator Louis Bardey (1851-1915). He exhibited in Lyon from 1900 and participated in various Lyon fairs. In Lyon, and during his travels in Burgundy and on the Côte d'Azur, he made sketches and paintings of landscapes. Faithful to the traditional style taught at the academy, he painted landscapes, flowers,
