SILOÉ : Asylum founded in 1858 for boys : 1°

EBEN-HÉZER : Asylum founded in 1862 for epileptic girls.

BÉTHEL : Asylum founded in 1863 for epileptic boys.

LE REPOS : Asylum founded in 1875 for incurable schoolmistresses, widowed ladies or destitute young ladies.

LA RETRAITE : Asylum founded in 1876 for Handmaids and women who were infirm or without resources and whose education did not allow them to be admitted to the Repos.

LA MISÉRICORDE : Asylum founded in 1878 for girls : 1° Idiots or spoiled ; 2° epileptics or invalids.

LA COMPASSION : Asylum founded in 1881 for boys : 1° Idiots or spoiled ; 2° epileptics or invalids.

NEW BETHESDA BUILT IN 1891

Founded in 1848 by Pastor Jean Antoine (known as John) Bost, the "John Bost Asylums" of La Force (Dordogne) were created to accommodate people in social distress and children in a semi-open environment. disabled, sick, incurable for whom nothing was planned.
