Total length : 42,5 cm ; Blade length : 22,55 cm

Dagger with a single-edged wrought iron blade ending in a bevelled point.

The cylindrical fuse is made of marine ivory, while the ferrule is made of wood covered with a silver insert decorated with filigree friezes.

The scabbard is made of wood covered with silver and decorated with twisted filigree and flowers.
