Delightful oval-shaped portraits in pastels with watercolor and gouache highlights of two children of the upper middle class leafing through a book, the second of two sisters, the youngest holding a rabbit in her arms. Endowed with great realism and finely executed by this famous portrait painter of Scottish origin who notably produced portraits of the Prussian royal family and the Duke and Duchess of Montrose as well as the physicist Michael Faraday giving a lecture at the Royal Institution in 1855.
