This interesting painting is the work of Alfred Jeanmongin painter born in Lure (Haute Saône) in the 19th century who died in the 20th century who devoted his life to painting. Genre and landscape painter. He studied at the Beaux Arts in Paris and was a pupil of Gérôme and Petitjean. He appeared at the Salon of French Artists and was an honorary professor at the Lycée Condorcet in Paris. Referenced to the Bénézit, it appears in the museums of Chartres and Gray. The canvas is of standard size 65 cm x 54 cm. With frame. There have been some SMALL restorations and a fine network of
