This vase is eccentric, baroque and fantasy style.

This decorative trend developed from the

Universal Exhibition of 1937.

Ceramic vase in the shape of an amphora.

A belly decorated with rectangles formed by four

diamonds, widening towards a broad shoulder

composed of a succession of moldings. The same

decor for the very high neck where the rim flares

out on either side forming the dense hair of

caryatids resembling sirens who make use of

handles. Ceramic with shades of green and brown

. Vase in good condition. Note: an old collage on

the arm of a caryatid (see photo)

It is easy to date this piece between 1936 and

1940 given the mark under the COPC vase
