This Confiturier opens in belt by a small drawer assembled in Dovetails. Below, it offers a small door with a recessed central panel, and molded frame, Gendarme's hat on the high crosspiece. It reveals two storage compartments formed by the presence of a removable shelf. Each opening has a cut iron lock and its key, all original.
