This spoon has three hallmarks; the silver hallmark 1st title to the 1st rooster, province 1798-1809 - The so-called State hallmark made after the revolution (figures a bearded man's head. The listello is oval) and the silversmith's hallmark LAD two grains of remedy and a different above.
