Description

Scene in a garden with a young lady holding flowers was executed by German painter Ernst Albert Fischer-Cörlin (1853 Körlin an der Persante - 1932 Berlin).

Fischer-Cörlin studied at the Prussian Academy of Arts in Berlin with Eduard Daeger and Julius Friedrich Anton Schrader, after which he was a master student with Anton von Werner for six years. After graduating, he worked as a freelance artist in Berlin. From 1877 to 1892 he took part in the exhibition of the Prussian Academy and from 1893 in the Great Berlin Art Exhibition.

Fischer-Cörlin was a member of the Allgemeine Deutsche Kunstgenossenschaft (General German Artist Union).
