Bronzed stucco frame 61x47 cm Born at the end of the 19th century in Marseille. His real name was Raoul Terrasson-Duvernoy. He was a student of Fine Arts in Paris, a painter trained like Toulouse-Lautrec by Fernand Cormon, a French painter. His wife Marthe Chevalier is a student in the piano class of the Conservatoire. When the couple moved to Remiremont, they took an important place there. Marthe Chevalier teaches the piano, while her husband teaches drawing and painting, while producing numerous paintings: (landscapes, portraits, nudes).
