Description

This very original belt from the Art Deco period is composed of a double chaining, the hallmark of which may indicate silver with medallions in galalith, a material used as a substitute for ivory, made from casein.

Hard and silky, galalith is non-flammable and is worked by hand, as seen on these finely chiseled medallions.

The Auguste Bonaz establishments in Oyonnax in France and Jakob Bengel in Germany were the two major users of this material to make magnificent and typical Art Deco jewellery.
