Small Dresser in Flamed Mahogany Veneer, originally used as a Vanity Unit. It opens on the top by a flap system called 'Piano', lined with an original rectangular mirror and held vertically by a brass compass. It reveals a space in White Marble in which you can deposit the necessary to get ready. This Rectiline cabinet also offers four drawers of identical depths, arranged in four rows and assembled in 'Dovetails'. All lock and are provided with their respective keys. We will note on their facades the pretty symmetrical designs formed by the Veneered Burl Mahogany, and which stand out from the sides, more Sober since in Wire Mahogany. The whole rests on a refined plinth. Rare by its small dimensions, notable for its Sobriety, this asexual Dresser can seduce both a Man and a Woman. ***** Period: Late 19th
