Description

Nice leg prosthesis signed and numbered with the plate of the house Deleury in Paris (formerly Werber). It is articulated at the knee and its wooden foot is also articulated. This prosthesis is made of leather, wood and metal systems. The top of the prosthesis is made of leather and is more padded for comfort. The back and the front were laced.

Ernest Adolphe Werber was a bandage maker, orthopedist and prosthetist practicing in Paris. He was present at the 1867 World's Fair and is mentioned in various writings until 1900. His successor Deleury is also quoted in various writings in 1918, 1919, concerning reviews, catalogs or manifestos on the disabled of war.
