Still life signed VISSON at the top left, representing the view, through an open window, of a table on which lie fruits and a pair of scissors. Painting counter-signed on the back by the artist, bearing the title of the work "Between the shutters", the date of 1997, a reference A15/NY6/107, and a number 55. Dimensions of the work: 46cm x 55cm. Frame dimensions: 66cm x 75cm. A slight lack of gilding on the frame. Philippe VISSON is an American painter, born in 1942 in New York, of Russian parents who changed their name from Akivisson to Visson because of the political situation in Europe at that time. He began to paint at the age of 16 and enjoyed immediate success by exhibiting in Paris. His eventful life alternated between political and diplomatic spheres on both
