Description

Kakemono of a pilgrimage for the seven shichifukujin gods of happiness: Benjaiten with his musical instrument (deities of arts and music), Bishamonten with his spear (god of warriors and traders), Daikokuten with bag and his hammer (god of wealth and fortune), ebisu with his fishing rod with a hooked sea bream (god of fishermen and luck), fukurokuju with a deer (god of wisdom, longevity and luck), hotei characterized by his obesity and his smile (god of fortune, protector of children, god of popularity), jurojin with his abnormally long skull (god of elders and longevity). The pilgrimage is to go to each of the temples and to receive a calligraphy from each of the temples, this makes it possible to bring to its owner the protections and the gifts brought by the deities.
