He was a painter of birds, genre-scenes, portraits, landscapes, compositions with figures and especially still lifes, often with poultry. He was also illustrator. He studied at the Academies of Tournai and Antwerp. He was a pupil of Joseph Stallaert (1825 - 1903). He worked mainly in Antwerp and also he lived and worked in England for a while.Quitton Edouard exhibited at the Salon of Namur in 1874. He also exhibited at the 35th Exhibition at the Casino in Ghent in 1892 following the centenary of the
