Screen in iron with heavy linen fabric covering by Stefan Herzog.

The naturalistic object has a poetic touch and recalls the works of Garouste and Bonetti.

The iron parts have a certain rusticity, the pores are open, making them look almost like branches. The slightly coarser beige-colored linen harmonizes perfectly with the brown iron frame. The 3-frame parts are mounted on 4 large oak wheels. The object is movable and, when postitioning, the wheels must be properly aligned. These oak wheels give the object the final touch.

Stefan Herzog was born in 1960 in Germany-Munich.
