Nahavand carpet in hand-knotted wool around 1940/50, measuring 140 cm wide by 197 cm long in very good condition, velvet, edges and fringes. A soft and shiny wool is characteristic and generally used for Nahavand carpets, which gives them a nice thickness.

It gives the patterns and designs of these rugs a strong personality combined with a great presence in a room.

These rugs are very solid, they often have a rectilinear design, partly inspired by nomadic pieces, but you don't find any like our model with softer, rounder shapes and skilful decorations.
